Hi from Lom Sak!

Hope you are well. This is just a quick update to compliment our facebook activities!

Wayne & Jen have been in Lom Sak for 8 months now, after resigning from Mercy International in June last year. We, along with Ben, Nang, Toby & Jess are currently attending the Lom Sak Full Gospel Church and working with the team there. Our main focus is teaching english to the church and local kids. We are currently in the process of expanding this to reach more of the local community. Many people are intersted in learning english and with ASEAN being implemented in Thailand there is a great need for poorer communities to have English language skills as english is the common language of the ASEAN community. We also do a youth group once a week and have a hangout centre for the kids on weekday afternoons. Once a month we visit a childrens home in Phetchabun & do english, bible activities & games with them. We hope to get the youth from the church involved with this next term too. Along with the church community we have discovered that locals are a bit afraid to come to activities at the church complex, so this week we have leased a building in the main part of town, which will make these activities more accessible and less threatening to the local community. We are also involved with our church's outreach activities in local H'tin tribe villages in the mountains behind Lom Sak & also in Nan Proviencie.



Ben is working on agricultural sustainanility projects to use with locals and the villagers in the mountains. We are working with a guy from another town, looking into starting up a green market to help the village people market their produce. This has been very sucessful in other areas. He has also moved his gym into town at this stage and is getting consistent numbers. He is starting to get to know the regulars & form stronger relationships with a number of the guys.
